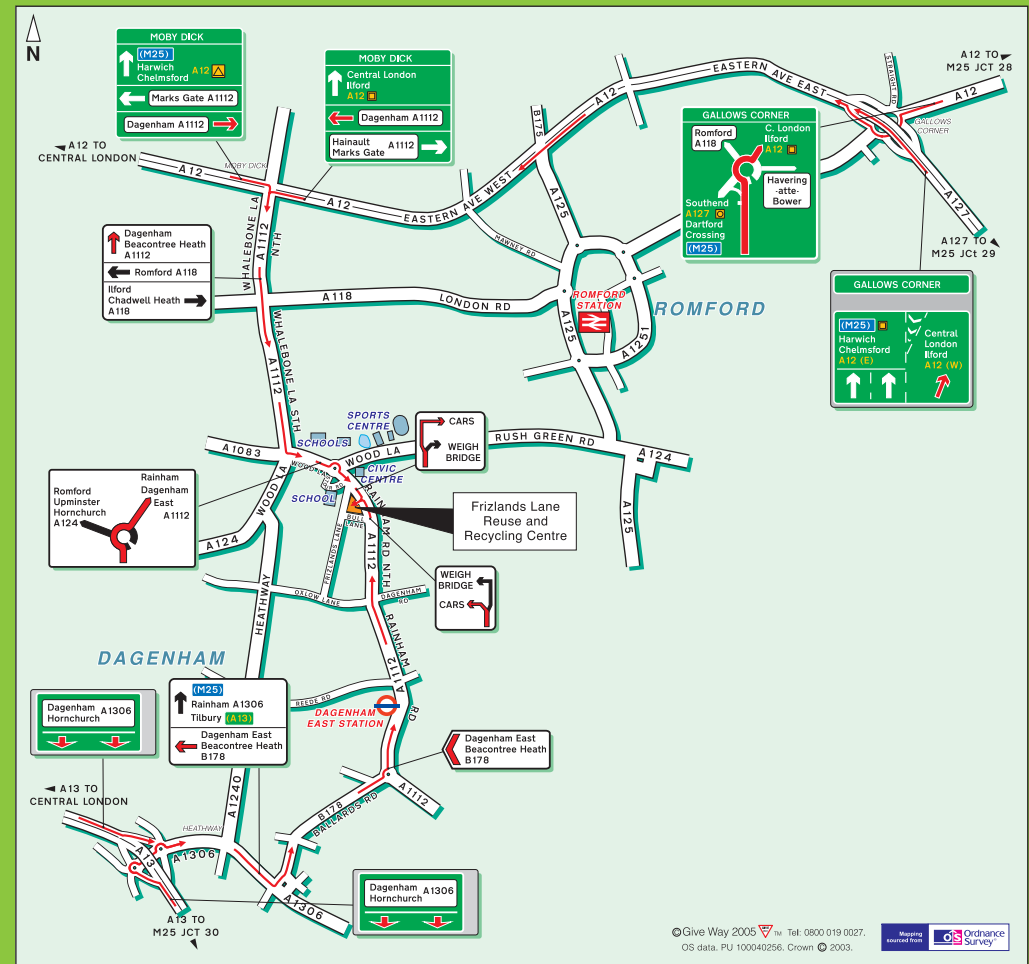

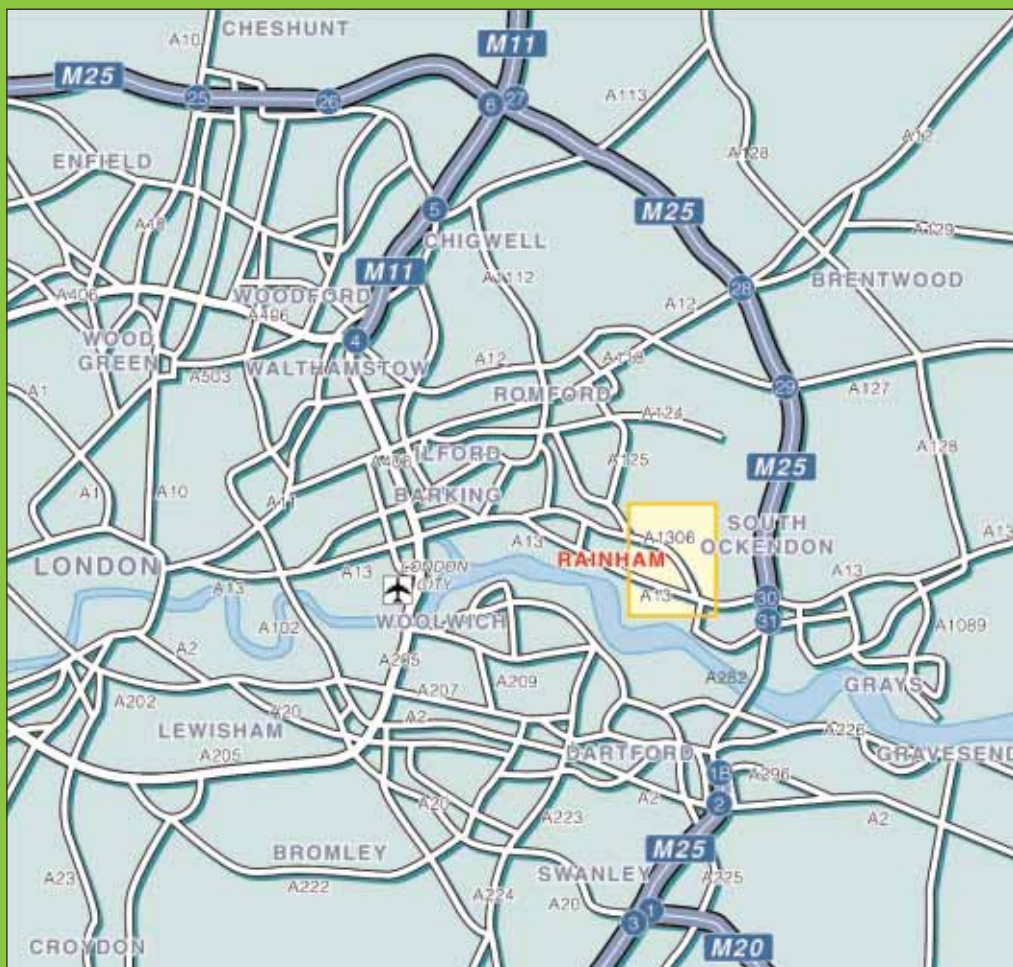

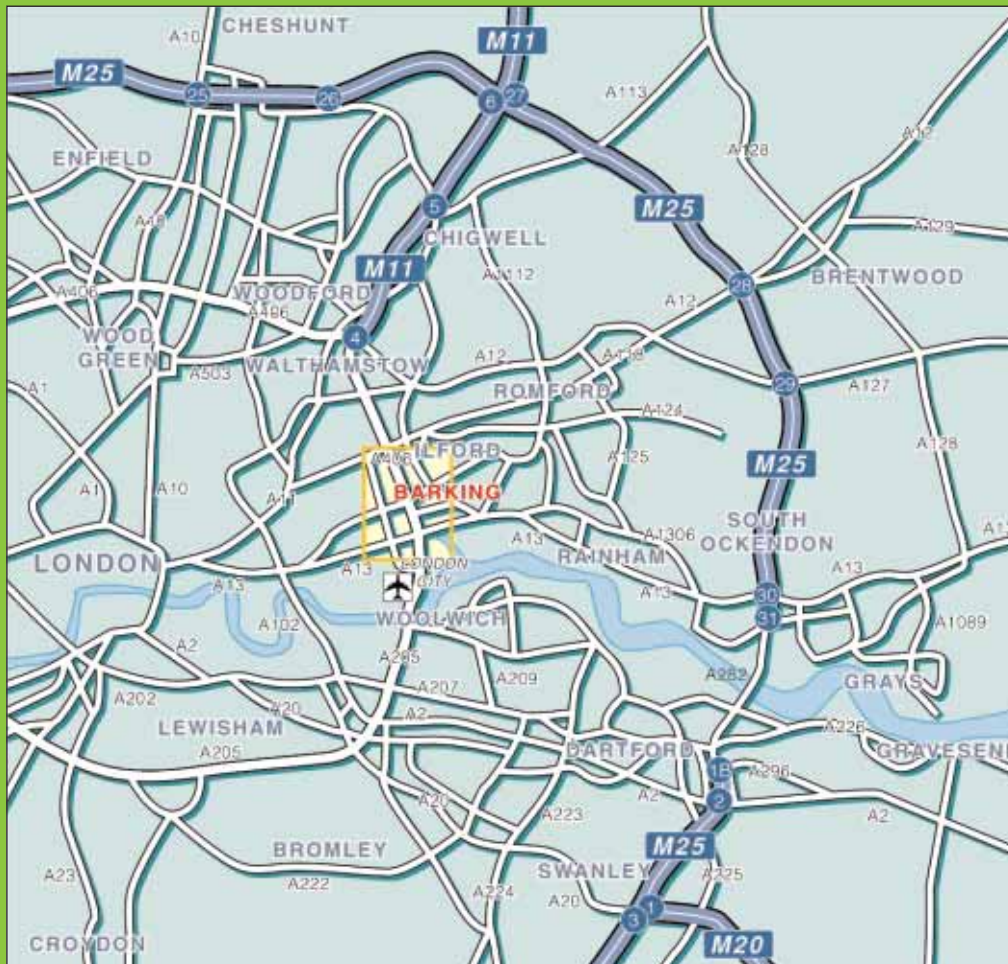
## Directions to the Jenkins Lane RRC:

### In a vehicle travelling east

Drive along the A13 and exit at the sign for the North Circular Road (A406). Drive across the roundabout and exit onto the slip road in the direction of the A13 east bound turn a hard left into Spur Road (signposted Hollywood Cinemas). \*Drive to the mini-roundabout and turn right and drive under the A13 passing the Hollywood Cinema on the left. The entrance to the Jenkins Lane RRC is on the right-hand side a little further along.

### In a vehicle travelling west

Drive along the A13 and take the exit for the North Circular Road. Drive up the slip road and enter into the right hand lane. Drive over the bridge and take the exit onto the A13 east bound while on the slip road turn a hard left into Spur Road. \*Continue as in first paragraph.

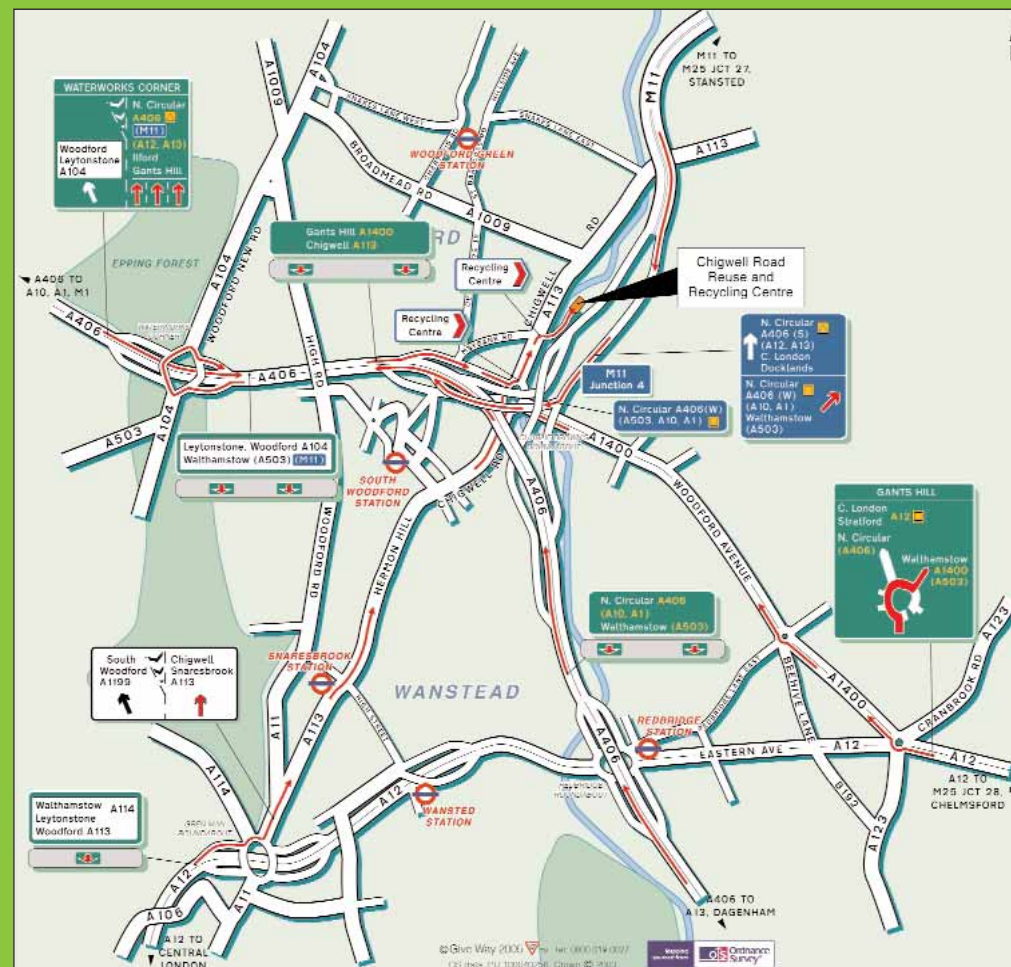
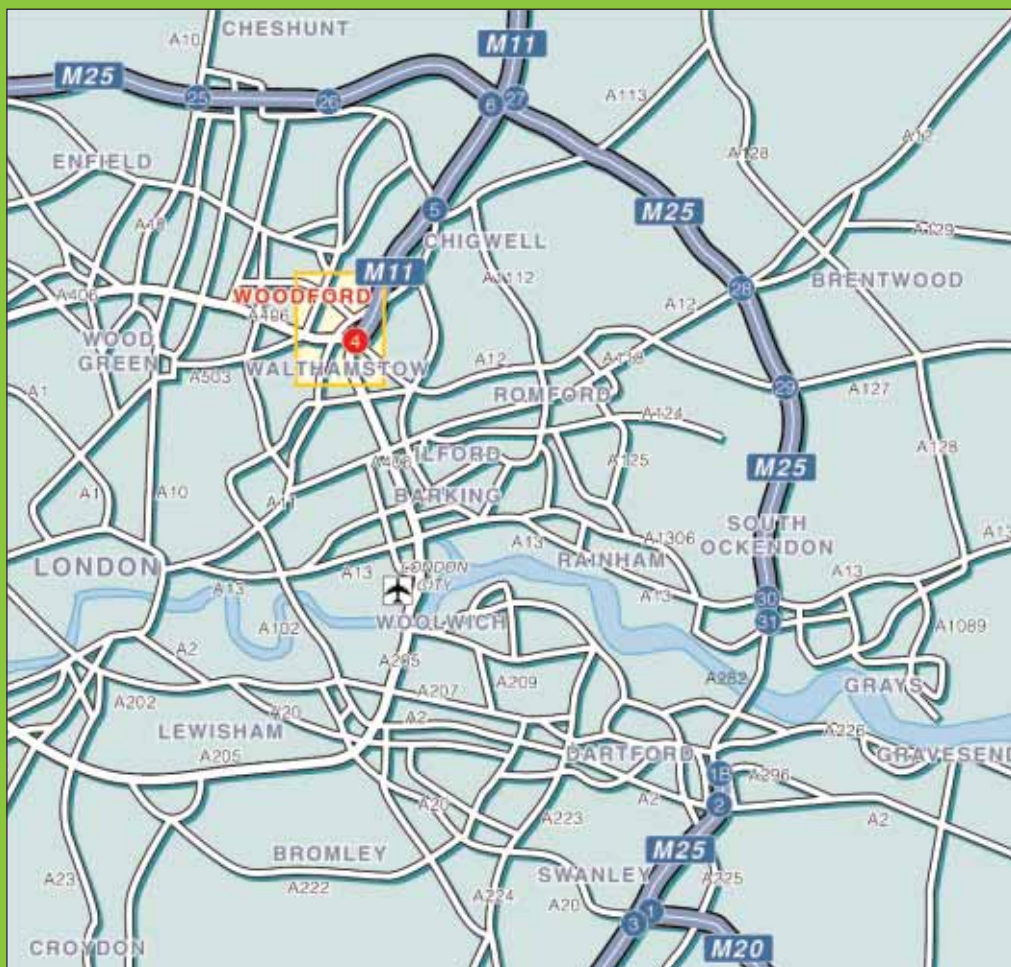

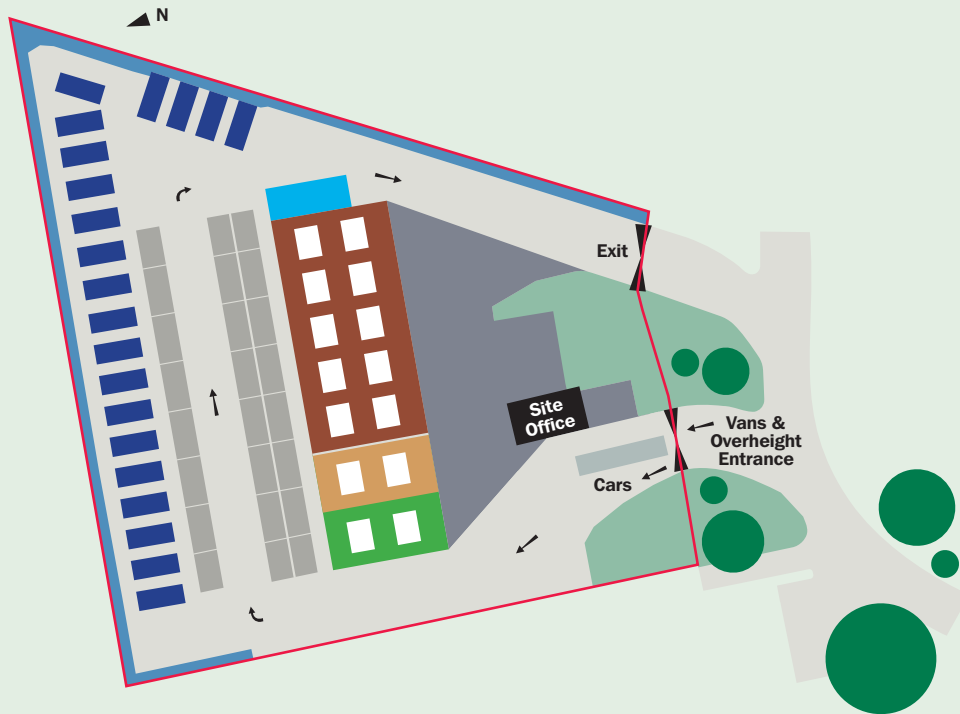

## Directions to the Chigwell Road RRC:

Chigwell Road RRC is located near Junction 4 off the A406/M11. Drivers need to take the north exit (A113) from the Charlie Brown roundabout and the entrance to the Chigwell Road RRC is approximately 500 metres.

The Chigwell Road RRC is not licensed to accept trade waste. The site is available for residents to dispose of their household rubbish, if residents need to hire a van to carry excess waste, the van will be weighed and recorded on our database.

Staff will also check the residents proof of residency (usually a utility bill and a driving licence will be requested) and the type of waste carried. Shanks East London reserves the right to refuse entry for any suspected trade waste deliveries.
